NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to and in compliance with the provisions of Section 108 and Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 (“**the Act**”) read with Rule 20 and Rule 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (“**Rules**”) General Circular No. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, the General Circular No. 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, the General Circular No. 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, the General Circular No. 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, General Circular No. 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020 and General Circular No. 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021 and including General Circular No. 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021, General Circular No. 3/2022 dated May 05, 2022, General Circular No. 10/2022 dated December 28, 2022, and General Circular No. 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023, issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (“**MCA Circulars**”) (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force, and as amended from time to time), Secretarial Standard-2 on general meeting (“**SS-2**”) issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (“**Listing Regulations**”) and other applicable laws and regulations, the resolutions being set out below are proposed to be passed by the members of the Company through postal ballot only by way of Remote E-voting process (“**E-voting**”). The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102(1) and other applicable provisions of the Act read with the rules setting out all material facts relating to the resolutions mentioned in this Postal Ballot Notice (“**Postal Ballot Notice**”) is annexed hereto.

Pursuant to the Rule 22 (5) of the Rules, the Board of Directors, through Board Resolution passed on 9th February, 2024, has approved the appointment of Mr. Vijay Yadav (Mem. No. FCS11990), Practicing Company Secretary, (Certificate of Practice No: 16806) as the scrutinizer (“Scrutinizer”) for conducting the E-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.

In accordance with the provisions of the MCA Circulars, shareholders can vote only through the remote e-voting process. Accordingly, the Company is pleased to offer a remote e-voting facility to all its shareholders to cast their votes electronically. Shareholders are requested to read the instructions in the Notes under the section “**General information and instructions relating to e-voting**” in this postal ballot notice (“Postal Ballot Notice”) to cast their vote electronically. Shareholders are requested to cast their vote through the e-voting process, which shall commence on **Friday, April 5, 2024 at 09:00 a.m. Hours IST** and end on **Saturday, May 4, 2024 at 05:00 p.m. Hours IST**, post that it will be strictly considered that no vote has been received from the shareholder. During this period, shareholders of the Company,



holding shares either in physical form or in dematerialized form, as on the cut-off date i.e. on **Friday, March 29, 2024**, may cast their vote electronically.

The Scrutinizer will submit his report to the Chairman of the Board or to any other person authorised by him after completion of scrutiny of the e-voting. The results shall be declared on or before **Tuesday, May 7, 2024** and will be communicated to BSE Limited (“BSE”), NSE (National Stock Exchange of India Limited), National Securities Depository Limited (“NSDL”) and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (“CDSL”) (together the “Depositories”), Bigshare Services Pvt.
